Hugely popular with audiences all over the world, Artistic Gymnastics looks set to draw huge crowds to North Greenwich Arena during the London 2012 Olympic Games.

### Did you know?

The word ‘Gymnastics’ comes from the Greek for ‘naked’ – early gymnasts used to perform Without any clothes.

### A ‘Perfect 10’

is no longer the top score in Gymnastics. Open-ended scoring was introduced in 2006.

Shun Fujimoto competed with a broken kneecap in order to help Japan win gold in the team competition at the Montreal 1976 Games. Soviet gymnast Larisa Latynina has 18 Olympic medals, the most ever won by a single athlete in any sport.
